Friday March 28, 2025

The Citizens Advisory Council for The Huntingdon-Bedford-Fulton Area Agency on Aging met on Friday March 28, 2025 at the Hopewell Senior Center. Prudence Harclerode, President of the Citizens Advisory Council opened the meeting with the Pledge and Prayer.

- 1- Prudence welcomed all council members and guests to the meeting.
- 2- Discussed January 31 meeting with Legislature on context, future ideas, and if there were any changes to be made. All positive vibes from Advisory Council and community.
- 3- Connie Brode and Lori Heaton discussed their day at AAA Legislative Day at the Capital in which was the next step following our January 31st meeting. They felt 3 out of the 4 meetings went very well with understanding of the need for a larger budget to work with for the aging population. Hopefully some changes with Lottery for more income, as advertised about the lottery.
- 4- There were 2 financial handouts distributed to all, reviewed Home Meals and Guardianship for understanding and costs.
- 5- Lori Heaton explained CAPE monitoring process, how they used to do in in sections now do an overall assessment of the Agency. This will be the first one of the new process.
- 6- Tony Molinari went over Transportation about building expansion, looking to expand with more drivers due to more scheduled trips. We received 7 new vehicles and 4 more buses will arrive in July. Now fully staffed in Central Dispatch.
- 7- The Agency feels the Fair increase at the beginning of the year has had virtually no impact on the Agency.
